On August 31, 2020, Triumph Bancorp, Inc. (the "Company") issued a press release announcing that the board of directors of the Company declared a quarterly cash dividend on its 7.125% Series C Fixed-Rate Non-Cumulative Perpetual Preferred Stock (the "Series C Preferred Stock") of \$19.99 per share (equivalent to \$0.49975 per depositary share representing a 1/40 interest in a share of Series C Preferred Stock). Such dividend is payable September 30, 2020, to shareholders of record on September 15, 2020.
